The original members of Journey came together in San Francisco. CA in 1973 under the auspices of former Santana manager Herbie Herbert. Originally called the Golden Gate Rhythm Section and intended to serve as a backup aroup for established Bay Area artists, the band included Santana alumni Neal Schon on lead guitar and Gregg Rolie on keyboards and lead vocals. Bassist Ross Valory and rhythm guitarist George Tickner, both of Frumious Bandersnatch, rounded out the group. Prairie Prince of The Tubes served as drummer. After one performance in Hawaii, the band quickly abandoned the "backup group" concept and developed a distinctive jazz fusion style. After an unsuccessful radio contest to name the group, roadie John Villanueva suggested the name "Journey". The band's 1st public appearance came at the Winterland Ballroom on New Year's Eve 1973 to an audience of 10,000. On the following day, the band flew to Hawaii to perform at the Diamond Head Crater to a larger audience. Prairie Prince rejoined The Tubes shortly thereafter; on February 1st, 1974, the band hired British drummer Aynsley Dunbar, who had recently worked with David Bowie and had been a member of the second iteration of Frank Zappa's Mothers of Invention. The new line-up made its debut on February 5th, 1974, at the Great American Music Hall in front of Columbia Records executives and secured a recording contract with the label. The band went on to perform at venues around the Bay Area. Journey went into CBS Studios in November 1974 with producer Roy Halee to record its debut album, Journey. The album was released in April 1975, entering the Billboard charts at No. 138. Rhythm guitarist Tickner left the band due to the amount of heavy touring the band was doing in promoting the album, allowing Schon to take on full guitar duties. The band entered the studio again in late 1975 to record Look into the Future, which was released in January 1976 and entered the Billboard Top 200 charts at No. 100. The band promoted the album with a 2-hour performance at the Paramount Theatre in Seattle, WA which later aired on the radio as touring continued to promote the album. From May to October of 1976, the band went to His Master's Wheels Studios to record its 3rd studio album, titled Next, which like its predecessor was produced by the band. This album had a much more commercial sound, while keeping the band's jazz fusion and progressive rock roots intact. The album was released in February and charted on the Billboard Top 200 at No. 85. However, sales didn't improve, and Columbia Records was on the verae of droppina the band.

According to the Recording Industry Association of America, Journey has sold 48 million albums in the U.S., making them the 25th best-selling band. Their worldwide sales have reached over 80 million records globally, making them one of the world's bestselling bands of all time. A 2005 USA Today opinion poll named Journey the 5th-best U.S. rock band in history. Their songs have become arena rock staples and are still played on rock radio stations around the world. Journey ranks No. 96 on VH1's 100 Greatest Artists of All Time.

Me and my parents like Journey because it's one of the most wondrous Rock bands in the early 80's. Before I started listening to Journey, I was watching a trailer to Mr. Deeds until the song called Don't Stop Believin pops up. After the song was over, I absolutely loved it because this is the first time I ever listened to them. As for me, I must give Journey another A.


What is your favorite part? Sonic is going fast

The Mayan people were Mesoamerican culture which is from 250 ce to 900 ce (meaning "Common Era"). The Mayan civilization had more than 40 cities, each with people between 5,000 and 50,000. They lived in the northwestern area of Central America. They were greatly well known for developing calendar systems that were intricate. They were also known for their stone buildings which comprised of pyramids and temples. The Mayan people were even the first people to put into practice the theory of zero. The Mayan people resided in regions of Central America and Mexico. Some of the countries they lived in are Guatemala, Honduras, Belize, El Salvador and Nicaragua. The majority of the Mayan people lived in huts that they built from wood or palm fiber and then they covered them with mud. They also fabricated cities with complex stepped stone pyramids, asphalted roadways, raised walkways, wide plazas, and shrines for spiritual offerings. Dignified palaces for the godly rulers were at the center of each city. The Mayan people planted crops such as corn, beans, squash, cassava, tomatoes, sweet potatoes, and papaya. They used slash-and-burn farming, along with irrigation and patio. They devoted flora & fauna deities, inclusive of gods of the sun, moon, rain, and corn. In saintly formalities, they assassinated people they apprehended during fights. The Mayan children form aristocratic kinsfolk studied math, science, writing, and cosmology, but impoverished children only learned their parent's jobs.
