CHEESY CRACKERS INGREDIENTS

- 1/3 CUP UNSWEETENED COCOA POWDER
- 2 TABLESPOONS UNSALTED BUTTER
- 1/4 TEASPOON RASPBERRY EXTRACT
- 2 EGGS, DIVIDED
- 1/2 CUP MILK
- 4 TABLESPOONS SUGAR, DIVIDED
- 1/4 TEASPOON SALT
- 1 TEASPOONS BAKING POWDER
- 6 OZ FRESH RASPBERRIES, WASHED AND PATTED DRY, PLUS MORE FOR GARNISH
- POWDERED SUGAR, FOR GARNISH



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. 1. PREHEAT THE OVEN TO 325 DEGREES F. PLACE 4
 (4 OZ.) RAMEKINS ON A BAKING SHEET AND SPRAY
 WITH NON-STICK COOKING SPRAY.
- 2. IN A MEDIUM SAUCEPAN OVER MEDIUM HEAT, ADD THE COCOA POWDER AND BUTTER, STIRRING FREQUENTLY UNTIL THE BUTTER IS MELTED AND IT BEGINS TO FORM A PASTE. REMOVE FROM THE HEAT AND ALLOW TO SLIGHTLY COOL. WHISK IN THE RASPBERRY EXTRACT, 2 EGG YOLKS, MILK, 2 TABLESPOONS SUGAR, SALT AND BAKING POWDER. STIR UNTIL A SMOOTH CONSISTENCY IS REACHED.
- 3. IN A LARGE BOWL, USE AN ELECTRIC MIXER TO BEAT THE EGG WHITES UNTIL SOFT PEAKS FORM. SLOWLY ADD THE REMAINING 2 TABLESPOONS SUGAR AND CONTINUE MIXING UNTIL SHINY STIFF PEAKS FORM, APPROXIMATELY 2-4 MINUTES. GENTLY FOLD THE FOAMED EGG WHITES INTO THE CHOCOLATE MIXTURE, FOLLOWED BY THE RASPBERRIES.
- 4. DIVIDE THE BATTER EVENLY BETWEEN THE 4
 PREPARED RAMEKINS. PLACE THE BAKING SHEET IN
 THE PREHEATED OVEN. BAKE FOR 20-22 MINUTES OR
 UNTIL THE CAKES ARE PUFFED AND THE TOPS LOOK
 DRY BUT THE CENTERS ARE STILL MOIST.
- 5. GARNISH WITH ADDITIONAL RASPBERRIES AND POWDERED SUGAR. OPTIONAL: TOP WITH A DOLLOP OF WHIPPED CREAM OR A SCOOP OF VANILLA ICE CREAM. SERVE WARM.
